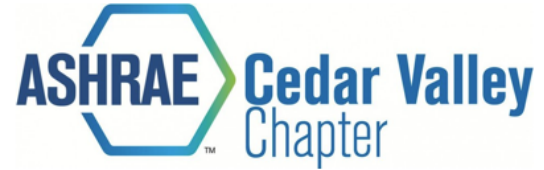

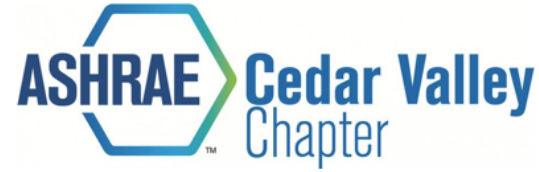

## September 2025

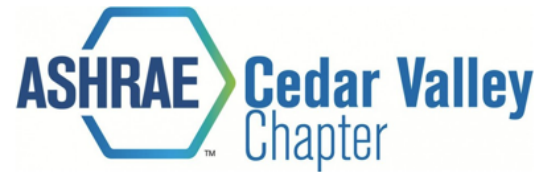

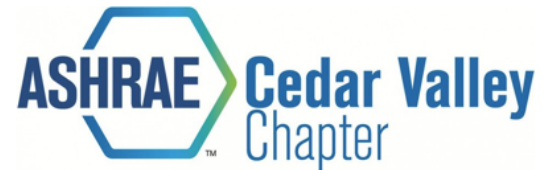
